



The Cabot Fire Explorer program is designed for young adults, ages 14-20, who show the desire to serve in the fire and emergency services careers. Participating in the program explorers can expect:

- To be pushed towards continued education
- Have a focus on safety
- Create and maintain mentor relationships
- Receive CPR & First Aid training
- Receive key career path training

Fire explorers will also be involved in numerous other topics to prepare for a solid foundation in the fire service. Meetings will be twice a month with additional training and/or community events throughout the year. Explorers will be required to maintain an attendance of 80% to all explorer post functions.
