ORDINANCE NO. __ OF 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO SET MILLAGE TAX RATES TO BE COLLECTED IN 2017 FOR THE CITY OF CABOT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, state law mandates that the county quorum court adopt an ordinance prior to the end of the year which establishes the various millage rates for assessments on real and personal property for the coming year; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 millage rates shall be established as stated in the following sections; subject to the approval of this governing body.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CABOT, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The rate of taxation of real and personal property in the City of Cabot, Arkansas for certain City purposes are hereby fixed, established and levied as follows

SECTION 3: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: EMERGENCY. It is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare that the proper millage rates be stated each year, and this information be promptly communicated with the Lonoke County government in order to assure that appropriate tax mileages are put in to effect for the following calendar year; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
