The Cabot City Council held its monthly Work Session on Monday, May 6, 2019 in the City Annex Council Chambers. Council Members present were: Ed Long, James Reid, Kevin Davis, Damon Bivins, Matt Webber, Ronald Waymack, Doug Warner and Norma Naquin. Others present: Mayor Kincade, City Attorney Jim Taylor, and City Clerk & Treasurer Tammy Yocom.

Ed Long, Chairman of the Public Works Committee, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Municipal Services: (Ed Long)

1. Wastewater Rate Increase – The attorney for the Wastewater Commission addressed the Council. He announced it is now necessary to have sufficient funds to cover day to day costs, in addition to funds to cover depreciation amounts. They have not increased wastewater rates since early 2000 and they are requesting the increase in rates to meet legal obligations. Discussion. Motion to place this legislation on May's Council Meeting Agenda, in addition to a Public Hearing, by Doug, second by Damon. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Community Development Input – No action.



1. Community Input – Meeting tomorrow night at 6:30 p.m.


