

Cabot City Council Work Session
Cabot City Annex / Council Chambers
June 3, 2019
6:30 p.m.

The Cabot City Council held its monthly Work Session on Monday, June 3, 2019 in the City Annex Council Chambers. Council Members present were: Ed Long, James Reid, Damon Bivins, Matt Webber, Ronald Waymack, Doug Warner and Norma Naquin. Kevin Davis was absent. Others present: Mayor Kincade, City Attorney Jim Taylor, and City Clerk & Treasurer Tammy Yocom.

Ed Long, Chairman of the Public Works Committee, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Municipal Services: (Ed Long)

1. Nuisance Abatement & Property Maintenance Code – Ed long requested that they “hold off” on this legislation. He stated it is not ready for review. He also asked Norma and Damon to work with Crystal in getting this ready for adoption. He would like to review it at the June MSC meeting. Both agreed to the request. No action.
2. Levying Alcohol Beverage Tax – Norma announced Cabot is the only city she could find that does not have an “alcohol tax”. She is proposing to levy a 5% tax due monthly to the City Treasurer. Discussion. Ed Long suggested the legislation include language to revoke the business license should the alcohol tax become delinquent much like the A&P/Business License revocation process already established. Motion to include revocation of Business License if alcohol tax becomes delinquent by Doug, second by Damon. Motion passed 7-0. Motion to place this legislation, as amended, on this month’s Council Meeting agenda by James, second by Damon. Motion passed 7-0. Discussion on “ear marking” this money for a purpose. It was determined to leave in General Fund for now.
3. Joe Gunderman addressed the council with information regarding the bid amount on the mini excavator, which was approved in a previous meeting. He explained that all bid amounts were pre-tax and the lowest bidder is still the lowest bidder, however, the amount of purchase has increased to \$67,863.17 to include tax.
4. Public Works Community Input-None

Budget & Personnel: (Doug Warner)

1. Meeting was turned over to Doug at 6:47. Nothing on agenda. No action.

Police & Fire: (Damon Bivins)

1. Meeting was turned over to Damon at 6:48. Nothing on agenda. No action.
2. Chief Davis announced the Police Department is working with Children’s Hospital on a Special Needs Junior Police Academy. It will be held on June 27th at the hospital. All are looking forward to the special event.

Community Development: (Kevin Davis)

1. 6:53. Deborah Moore gave a library update. She stated 1,314 people have been to the library in person to sign up for the summer reading program in addition to those who have registered on line. She is looking forward to a successful summer.

2. In Kevin's absence Damon asked Amy Williams for a report. She is currently working with Habitat for Humanity, the new hospital and the owner of the K-Mart building.
3. Community Development Input – None


Military Affairs Committee (Ron Waymack)

1. 6:55. Nothing on Agenda per Ron.


