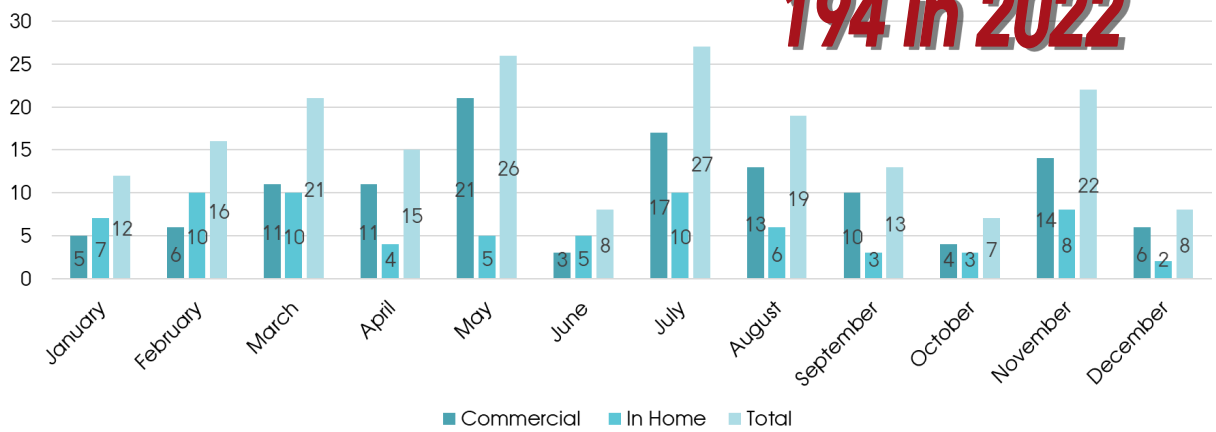

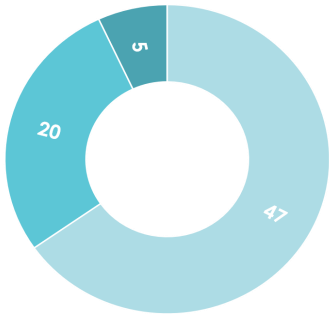


Total Business Licenses in Cabot\*

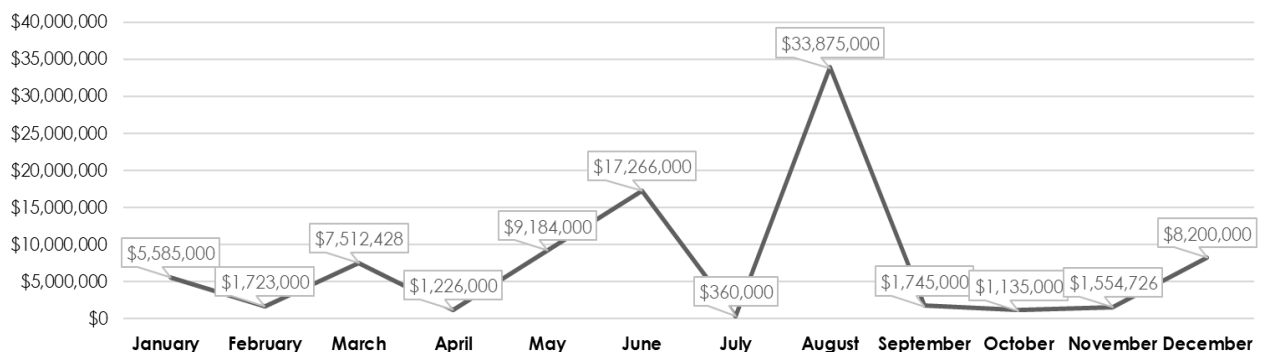
